Abstract:

The network scalability and bandwidth improved a lot during the last decade, but lowering the network latency is still too far away from the users' satisfaction. This talk will start from the very different requirements and reasons behind on different layers. Then the talk will introduce our novel research from the data center networking on the cloud side, to the fancy mobile apps like VR.

Yong Cui is a Professor of Computer Science and Technology at Tsinghua University, China. He received all degrees at Tsinghua University. He served or serves at the editorial boards on IEEE TPDS, IEEE TCC, IEEE Network and IEEE Internet Computing. He published over 100 papers with several Best Paper Awards and he co-authors 10 Internet standard documents (IETF RFC). His research interests include mobile cloud computing and network architecture.
